What does the fund invest in?

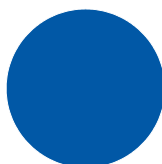
The fund seeks to provide some interest income while protecting capital and providing liquidity by investing primarily in high quality debt securities. It will ensure that it meets at all times the definition of a "money market fund" as prescribed by securities legislation. The Fund may invest up to 30% of its assets in foreign securities.

The charts below give you a snapshot of the fund's investments on April 30, 2024. The fund's investments will change.

How risky is it?

The value of the fund can go down as well as up. You could lose money.

One way to gauge risk is to look at how much a fund's returns change over time. This is called "volatility".

In general, funds with higher volatility will have returns that change more over time. They typically have a greater chance of losing money and may have a greater chance of higher returns. Funds with lower volatility tend to have returns that change less over time. They typically have lower returns and may have a lower chance of losing money.

Risk rating

IA Clarington Investments Inc. has rated the volatility of this fund as **low**.

This rating is based on how much the fund's returns have changed from year to year. It doesn't tell you how volatile the fund will be in the future. The rating can change over time. A fund with a low risk rating can still lose money.

No guarantees

Like most mutual funds this fund doesn't have any guarantees. You may not get back the amount of money you invest.

How has the fund performed?

This section tells you how Series DA units of the fund have performed since its inception. Returns are after expenses have been deducted. These expenses reduce the series' returns.

Year-by-year returns

This section tells you how Series DA units of the fund have performed in past calendar years. However, this information is not available because the series has not yet completed a calendar year.

Best and worst 3-month returns

This section shows the best and worst returns for Series DA units of the fund in a 3-month period. However, this information is not available because the series has not yet completed a calendar year.

Average return

This section shows the value and annual compounded rate of return of a hypothetical \$1,000 investment in Series DA units of the fund. However, this information is not available because the series has not yet completed 12 consecutive months.

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Who is this fund for?

Investors who:

- Seek interest income and preservation of capital while gradually purchasing securities of another underlying IA Clarington Fund (the "Transfer Fund") over a 52 week period;
- Are looking to reduce the risk associated with timing a single lump sum investment in the market;
- Are comfortable with the risks of the selected Transfer Fund.

Do not invest in this series if you are looking to make a lump sum purchase of the fund or of another IA Clarington fund.

A word about tax

In general, you'll have to pay income tax on any money you make on a fund. How much you pay depends on the tax laws where you live and whether or not you hold the fund in a registered plan, such as a Registered Retirement Savings Plan or a Tax-Free Savings Account.

Keep in mind that if you hold your fund in a non-registered account, fund distributions are included in your taxable income, whether you get them in cash or have them reinvested.

How much does it cost?

The following tables show the fees and expenses you could pay to buy, own and sell Series DA units of the fund. The fees and expenses, including any commissions, can vary among series of a fund and among funds. Higher commissions can influence representatives to recommend one investment over another. Ask about other funds and investments that may be suitable for you at a lower cost.

1. Sales charges

Series DA units are only available under the Front End Option.

Sales charge option	What you pay		How it works

Front End Option	0% to 5% of the amount you buy	\$0 to \$50 on every \$1,000 you buy	You and your representative decide on the rate. The initial sales charge is deducted from the amount you buy. It goes to your representative's firm as a commission.

2. Fund expenses

You don't pay these expenses directly. They affect you because they reduce the fund's returns.

As at March 31, 2024, the fund's expenses were 1.24% of its value. This equals \$12.40 for every \$1,000 invested.

Management expense ratio (MER) This is the total of the fund's management fee (including the trailing commission), fixed administration fee and operating expenses.	1.24%

More about the trailing commission

The trailing commission is an ongoing commission. It is paid for as long as you own the fund. It is for the services and advice that your representative and their firm provide to you. IA Clarington Investments Inc. pays the trailing commission to your representative's firm. It is paid from the fund's management fee and is based on the value of your investment. IA Clarington Investments Inc. is not currently paying the full trailing commission. The rate depends on the sales charge option you choose, and will reflect the rate applicable to the series of the Transfer Fund that you choose at the time of purchase. The highest rates are shown below.

Sales charge option	Amount of trailing commission

Front End Option	0.25%	\$2.50 each year on every \$1,000 invested

3. Other fees

You may have to pay other fees when you buy, hold, sell or switch units of the fund.

Fee	What you pay
Short-term trading fee	Up to 2.00% of the value of units you sell or switch within 30 days of buying them. This fee goes to the fund.
Switch fee	Your representative's firm may charge you up to 2.00% of the value of units you switch.

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What if I change my mind?

Under securities law in some provinces and territories, you have the right to:

- withdraw from an agreement to buy mutual fund securities within two business days after you receive a simplified prospectus or Fund Facts document, or
- cancel your purchase within 48 hours after you receive confirmation of the purchase.

In some provinces and territories, you also have the right to cancel a purchase, or in some jurisdictions, claim damages, if the simplified prospectus, Fund Facts document or financial statements contain a misrepresentation. You must act within the time limit set by the securities law in your province or territory. For more information, see the securities law of your province or territory or ask a lawyer.
