Interest rate payments for the following securities in the fund are reset periodically: senior loan (term loans), CLO (Collateralized Loan Obligations), MBS (Mortgage-Backed Security), and ABS (Asset-Backed Security). As a result, in calculating the modified duration of the Fund, these securities are individually assigned a duration based on its interest rate reset frequency.
